Dr JS Moroka Local Municipality offers opportunities for qualifying Grade 12 or those who were writing Grade 12 examination in 2017, from historically disadvantaged families residing within its areas of jurisdiction wishing to undertake full time studies at any Mpumalanga Technical and Vocational Education and Training College (TVET), South African University or University of Technology in the following fields:

- **Diesel Mechanic X2**
- **Petrol Mechanic X2**
- **Water Care Treatment X4**
- **Records and Archives Management X1**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Only citizens residing within the Dr JS Moroka Municipal jurisdiction can apply.
- Learners must meet admission/ entry requirements of the tertiary institution or TVET Colleges they are registered with.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All applicants must first apply to the universities or TVET Colleges they intend to study before applying for the Executive Mayor's Bursary Scheme. Letter of acceptance or proof of registration with the university must be attached on the Bursary Application form.
- Successful candidates should be willing to undertake employment in the Municipality for the period equal to his or her study duration.
- Selected bursars will be expected to enter into a contractual agreement with the Municipality.
- The bursary covers Tuition, Learning materials, accommodation and meals.
